

IMPOSSIBLE MISSION? NOT FOR US!

Form takes priority over function in many of today's custom home projects.

This designers of this \$2.5M custom home in the Moore Park area of Toronto, Canada spared no expense and covered all the details, except one. An oversight in the HVAC planning meant that YogaPipe was not only beneficial, but necessary, to avoid costly backyard hardscape rework.

Bulkheads, drop ceilings and mechanical rooms, all seen as unsightly and utilitarian, often become afterthoughts and are even sometimes relegated to the status of “necessary evils.” When asked why they use YogaPipe, many of our installing contractors answer: “It’s impossible NOT to use it!” On this particular job, that was exactly the case.

A \$2.5M custom home in Toronto, Canada was nearing completion when the HVAC team was called in to complete the installation of an air conditioning system. To their surprise, the architect/designer had mandated that the AC condensing unit be mounted away from the home on a custom, poured concrete pad, with a 5" ABS service conduit that ran underground from the pad to the mechanical room in the basement, nearly 70' away.

Over the course of the conduit’s run there was a 90° elbow at each end; one coming through the slab foundation into the mechanical room and one coming up through the concrete pad from almost 4' below grade.

While the required electrical wiring was easy to run in this location, apparently the designers “forgot” that a refrigerant line set is also required. In this case, copper was not going to work. Having been in a YogaPipe training session previously, the installing contractor contacted a YogaPipe sales representative for consultation on the application, and it was determined that YogaPipe was the perfect, and only, solution due to its strong and flexible nature. Using a heavy duty, “fish tape” style apparatus, insulated 7/8" YogaPipe ACR was pulled through the conduit almost 70'. The end result was a quick install in an extremely challenging application that, as an additional benefit, had no brazed joints or concealed potential fail points.
